Participation Criteria for the “Grünschnabel” Competition

In 2020, at the 14th Figura Theatre Festival in Baden, Switzerland, the Cantonal Council of Aargau will award the ninth “Grünschnabel” (Greenhorn) prize. Worth 10,000 Swiss Francs, it will go to a young theatre company starting out professionally and working in an original way with puppets and objects.

Participation in the “Grünschnabel” competition is subject to the following conditions:

Based on the documentation submitted **by July 31, 2019, at the latest**, the festival organizers will decide by January 31, 2020, at the latest which plays will be admitted to the programme. During this period the applicants must keep the festival dates blocked.

The festival organizers will select four to seven plays produced by young theatre companies whose careers date back **no more than six years prior to the festival**.

The nominated company must keep the dates from June 16–21, 2020, free and must be present at the prize presentation and celebration on June 21, 2020.

A jury appointed by Aargau's Cantonal Council and the festival organizers will judge the nominated and invited performances. The decision will be explained at the prize presentation.

The prize will be awarded either to an individual puppeteer or to an ensemble as a whole. Diploma work may be admitted if it has been developed further and taken on tour.

The fee is € 300 per person. The festival will cover the cost of a return journey, transportation, simple accommodation and food in the Festival centre.
